

PRIVACY POLICY - prosoccerchance.com

In accordance with Article 13 of the EU Regulation No. 2016/679 regarding the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), R5, Assist Sport Management by Fabio Tempesta (hereinafter also referred to as the "Controller"), with registered office at Calle Tuset No. 17, 1-2, ZIP - 08006, Barcelona (Spain), with VAT number: ES-Y0316092V, as the data controller (hereinafter "Controller"), informs you, in accordance with Article 13 of the GDPR, that the data provided by you will be processed as described below:

1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE DATA CONTROLLER AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

Under the Regulation, your personal data will be processed by Assist Sport Management by Fabio Tempesta, with registered office at Calle Tuset No. 17, 1-2, 08006, Barcelona (Spain), reachable at the email address info@prosoccerchance.com.

2. PURPOSE OF PROCESSING AND TYPES OF DATA

The Controller processes the personal data provided by you, such as name, surname, business name, email, telephone number, IP address, browsing preferences (hereinafter "Data") collected during your navigation on the website at www.prosoccerchance.com, as well as during communication via chat for assistance and when filling out online contact, collaboration, application, and registration forms published on the website. These Data will be used to fulfill your requests.

The Data subject to processing belong to the following categories:

- Common data, including but not limited to name and surname, place and date of birth, residence, phone number, email, a person's image, billing data;
- Other common data, such as those related to electronic communications (via the Internet or phone) related to communications made through email accounts, chat support, forms, and phone contacts, as well as data related to social profiles (e.g., LinkedIn, Facebook, Google).

If there is a need to process additional data not falling under the above-mentioned categories in the course of the activities requested by you, you will be promptly informed by Assist Sport Management by Fabio Tempesta.

3. COOKIES AND WEBSITE TRACKING

In compliance with EU Directive 2009/136/EC dated 25/11/2009, the Controller informs you that this website uses cookies or similar tools to improve our service and provide useful features to the user. This may include cookies from business partners that are stored on your computer or device when you visit our site (Cookie Policy). Please visit our business partners' websites for information on their cookie and privacy policies.

Cookies are small text files transferred to your computer or device through the web browser to allow us to recognize your browser and help us monitor site visitors, thereby enabling us to better understand which products and services will be most suitable for users. A cookie contains contact information and information useful for identifying the computer or device when visiting our site to assist the user during booking and searching activities and to provide a better user experience during navigation. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can change these settings to accept, reject, or delete cookies if you wish. If you choose to change these settings, certain functions and features may not operate as expected. The cookies used do not gather information stored on the computer or device.

4. LEGAL BASIS AND PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

Your personal data is processed solely for the purpose of managing and fulfilling the requests made, as per Article 6.1.b of the GDPR (processing necessary for the performance of pre-contractual measures requested by the data subject). Furthermore, only with your explicit consent (Article 6.1.a of the GDPR), they will be processed for purposes of (i) direct marketing, (ii) user profiling, (iii) communication to third-party partners for their own purposes.

5. PROCESSING METHODS AND STORAGE

Processing will be carried out using computer systems (cloud, internet, computers, and mobile devices) and, residually, in paper form, with appropriate measures to ensure confidentiality and security. Data will be stored in the Controller's databases for the time strictly necessary to fulfill your request, in compliance with the law and as specified above, except when current regulations require data to be stored for longer periods. In case of processing for the purposes mentioned in point 4 (i) and (ii), data will be stored for a maximum of twenty-four months.

6. NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSAL

Providing your data is optional. However, the failure to fill in the fields marked as necessary may affect the total or partial fulfillment of your request, as well as the successful completion of the service and its provision.

7. DATA ACCESS

Your Data will be processed for the purposes and with the methods described above by specifically authorized personnel and/or collaborators of the Controller, as well as by third parties (e.g., suppliers, professionals, banks, affiliates, business partners) performing outsourced activities on behalf of the Controller as external data processors.

8. DATA DISCLOSURE

The Controller may disclose your data to public entities to comply with obligations provided by laws, regulations, or European and national legislation, or as imposed by authorities, which will process them as independent data controllers. They may be communicated to third-party subjects

(e.g., suppliers, professionals, partners) performing instrumental or accessory activities for the requested services and for the purposes mentioned above, on behalf of the Controller as external data processors. The updated list of such subjects can be requested from the Data Controller at the addresses mentioned above. Your data, with your consent as per the preceding point 4 (iii), will be communicated to third-party subjects, such as customer companies or contractors, for their own purposes as independent data controllers. In general, the selected service providers operate through data centers located in the European Economic Area. If your data are to be transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA) for technical or statistical data management purposes, this will occur exclusively in full compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679, to third countries for which the European Commission has recognized specific adequacy guarantees or provided adequate data protection guarantees, through the adoption of Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission based on Decision 2010/87/EU for the transfer of personal data between EU countries to non-EU countries, specifying the additional security measures adopted to protect the data subject's privacy.

Therefore, data may be disclosed to:

all subjects with legal access to such data as required by regulatory provisions;
our collaborators and employees;
subjects appointed as external data processors by the Data Controller for personal data processing;
all natural or legal persons, public or private, when communication is necessary or functional to the establishment and management of the relationship, in the ways and for the purposes illustrated above, particularly to:

- accountants,
- legal consultants;
- labor consultants;
- business partners;
- suppliers;
- banks;
- public institutions;
- individuals responsible for administrative activities.

9. DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

You have the right to exercise your rights with the data controller at any time, as per Articles 15-22 of EU Regulation 2016/679, particularly the rights of access, rectification, integration, and, where permitted, data portability, as well as the right to erasure, limitation, or objection to data processing for legitimate reasons, and the right to object to automated decision-making, including profiling, and the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

ARTICLE 15 - RIGHT OF ACCESS

You have the right to obtain from the data controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data and information related to the processing.

ARTICLE 16 - RIGHT TO RECTIFICATION

You have the right to obtain from the data controller the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you without undue delay. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, you have the right to have incomplete personal data completed by providing a supplementary statement.

ARTICLE 17 - RIGHT TO ERASURE (RIGHT TO BE FORGOTTEN)

You have the right to obtain from the data controller the erasure of personal data concerning you without undue delay, and the data controller is obliged to erase personal data without undue delay.

ARTICLE 18 - RIGHT TO RESTRICTION OF PROCESSING

You have the right to obtain from the data controller restriction of processing where one of the following applies:

- a) the accuracy of the personal data is contested by you, for a period enabling the data controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data;
- b) the processing is unlawful, and you oppose the erasure of the personal data and request the restriction of their use instead;
- c) the data controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but you require them for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims;
- d) you have objected to processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of you.

ARTICLE 20 - RIGHT TO DATA PORTABILITY

You have the right to receive the personal data concerning you, which you have provided to a data controller, in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit this data to another data controller without hindrance from the data controller to which the personal data have been provided. When exercising your rights regarding data portability, you have the right to have the personal data transmitted directly from one data controller to another, where technically feasible.

ARTICLE 21 - RIGHT TO OBJECT

You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning you which is based on Article 6(1)(e) or (f), including profiling based on those provisions.

ARTICLE 22 - RIGHT NOT TO BE SUBJECT TO A DECISION BASED SOLELY ON AUTOMATED PROCESSING, INCLUDING PROFILING

You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you.

The aforementioned rights can be exercised by sending an email to the Data Controller at info@prosoccerchance.com. To ensure the protection of the data subject's personal information, we may need to request specific information to confirm the identity of the requesting data subject and thereby ensure the right to access the information (or exercise any of the other rights) is granted only to individuals with the right to receive such communications. This is another security measure aimed at protecting personal data. Requests for access to personal information (or to exercise any of the above-mentioned rights) are free of charge. However, if the request is clearly unfounded or excessive, we may charge a reasonable fee considering the administrative costs incurred to provide the information or refuse to fulfill the request in such circumstances.

10. INFORMATION UPDATE

Assist Sport Management by Fabio Tempesta will keep this information constantly updated and will be responsible for publishing updated information on the relevant websites.

Please note that, under Article 7 of EU Regulation No. 2016/679, you have the right to revoke your consent to the processing of personal data in writing.
